To provide an update for residents, families, staff, vendors and guests of Roselani Place, below is the current update to the Covid-19 cases within our Community.

Since last week's letter, we now have confirmation that 5 staff have tested positive since Jan 11, 2021; currently 3 of those staff members have been released from quarantine, while 2 are still considered active and are isolating at home.

159 tests have been conducted on staff and residents since we became aware of the positive staff member test results. With 5 positive cases, that brings our positivity rate to 3.14% overall.

Testing by both rapid antigen test as well as PCR is being done for staff and residents, and we are grateful for the assistance of Donna Nozaki and the Maui District Health Lab for their assistance with this process.

Thankfully, results from all of our previous tests of residents have come back negative during this second wave of covid-19.

Looking forward at the next 2 weeks, residents will be tested once a week, and staff will be tested every 4-5 days. As such, Phase II visitation by families and guests will have to be put on temporary hold until we are once again back at 0 active cases.

As vaccine availability increases on the islands, we will continue to facilitate staff and residents who elect to receive it; our next scheduled vaccination clinic is slated for February 11th.

The Roselani Team is working harder than ever and we appreciate the residents and your continued prayers, support and aloha you have given and continue to share.
